Vendors and Crafters Information & Application

Fees: \$30 for each 10' x 10' space, plus \$10 per table, if needed.

Date and Time: Saturday, October 3rd, 10 AM-4PM

Set-Up: 8AM -9:30 AM **All vehicles must be cleared from the display area by 9:30 AM. Parking for vendors will be in the uphill lot, behind the church.*

Break Down: Saturday, from 4 PM to 4:30 PM ******Under NO circumstances will vehicles be allowed on Festival Grounds PRIOR to 4 PM, for safety's sake.***

Please note that this festival is "rain or shine." There will be **NO** refunds of space fees, due to inclement weather.

Per the Fire Marshall, tent poles must be weighted down. Booth space locations will be assigned in advance, and clearly marked.

NOTE: NSF checks will be charged \$20.

Important: Any vendor selling packaged, consumable goods (i.e., sauces, jams, jerky, etc.,) **must carry insurance**. A copy of your insurance documentation **MUST** be sent in with your application.

No sales of alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, or vaping products are allowed, nor any weapons, drug paraphernalia, or potentially dangerous devices which might be considered in violation of the laws and/or the rules and regulations of the U.S. Government, the State of Connecticut, Windham County, the Town of Brooklyn, or the festival's organizers.

No alcoholic beverages, nor smoking is allowed in, or around, vendor booths. Any pets present must be under their owner's control, at all times. And, owners must clean up after their pets.

Trinity Episcopal Church is not responsible for any harm or damage caused by either a vendor's, or a guest's, pets.

Also, Trinity Episcopal Church, the Fall Festival, and its organizers are not responsible for any injuries, damage to, or loss of any items prior to, during, or following the festival. The vendor is responsible, and shall reimburse Trinity Episcopal Church, for any damage, loss, injury, or liability incurred by the church, the Fall Festival, and/or its organizers or attendees, caused by the actions of the vendors prior to, during, and following the festival.

Please note that **tables and chairs are not provided**. Although, you may request one or more tables, in your application, along with the rental fee of \$10 per table.

For your convenience, Trinity Episcopal Church will be offering a variety of delicious foods for purchase, this year.

Please note that **electrical hookups will not be available**, due to the outdoor location of this event.
